#### > What is the UJS Secure Web Portal?

The Secure Web Portal provides users the ability to access case information that is not made available to the public. Court staff, District Attorneys office staff, probation officers, police offiers, attorneys, and others can access important case and case participant information, based on assigned security roles using any computer with Internet access.
